What is the Guam Head Start Program?

The Guam Head Start Program provides education, health, nutrition and social services to children and their families that support SCHOOL READINESS AND FAMILY ENGAGEMENT. Children's development is enhanced in a center-based setting and parents are encouraged to participate in their child's education and in the community through home visits, family partnership agreements and volunteering. Bussing services are provided to Head Start children by the Division of Bus Operations of the Department of Public Works (with some exceptions).

Who Should Apply?

- Families with children born in 2010
- Families with children who turn five years old but do not meet the cut-off age for Kindergarten (children born August-December 2009)
- Families receiving TANF and other public assistance
- Families that meet the income guidelines
- Families with a child with a disability that meet the age requirement

- Natural parents
- Legal Guardians

Who can register a child? Registration for School Year 2014-2015 begins in April. Please call us in March at 475-0484 for our registration outreach schedule.

What do I need to bring?

- ✓ Parent or Guardian's picture identification (driver's license, Guam ID, Passport)
- ✓ Child's Birth Certificate (original or official stamped copy)
- ✓ Immunization Card (shot record)
- ✓ Child's social security card
- ✓ Legal documents (relating to guardianship or custody), Restraining Order
- ✓ Verification of income for the last 12 months (W-2 and copy of 2013 Income Tax Forms; check stubs from 2013-2014, Medicaid card, Public Assistance Certification Letter, MIP card, Child Support, TANF, Financial Aid (Pell Grant, other scholarships, fellowships etc.), Social Security benefits, GHURA Utility Reimbursements, Leave and Earning Statement (LES) for military
- ✓ Unemployment Verification and/or Statement of Support (if you are unemployed or have been unemployed within the past 12 months)
- ✓ Copy of IEP Placement from GDOE's Division of Special Education (if your child has a disability)
